

Program Aid – Bellevue

Support mental health program staff by assisting with therapeutic activities for adults with mental illness or emotional disturbance in skilling building programs. Activities include: living enhancement, socialization, recreation and arts; provide one-to-one listening skills, and help with groups in various settings. Support treatment services; record and maintain clients activities regarding socialization, recreation and other services provided; transport clients to activities using a county-owned van.

Candidate must:

- Have a current driver's license
- Communicate verbally with adults with mental illness or emotional disturbance and their families/friends
- Establish and maintain cooperative working relationships
- Provide outreach to a diverse population
- Maintain records and other related documents
- Facilitate basic, non-professional mental health services in a variety of settings
- Assist mental health staff with implementation of service plans
- Apply basic principles of health and human services
- Learn to input and access information utilizing a computer
- Stand and walk for extended periods of time maybe be required for some positions

Education and Experience:

Any combination of training and experience, that would provide the required knowledge and abilities, is qualifying. High school education or GED; must have a clear driving record.
